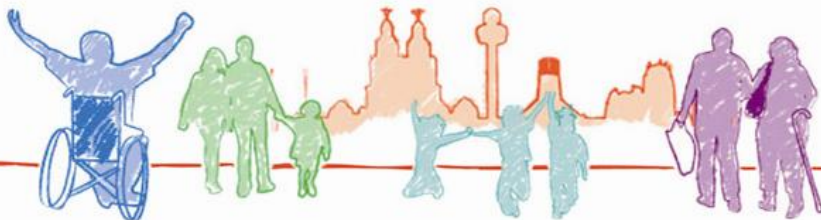
Signs and Symptoms of Lung Cancer

Coughing up blood



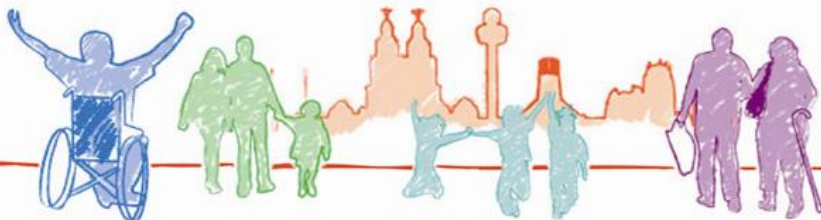
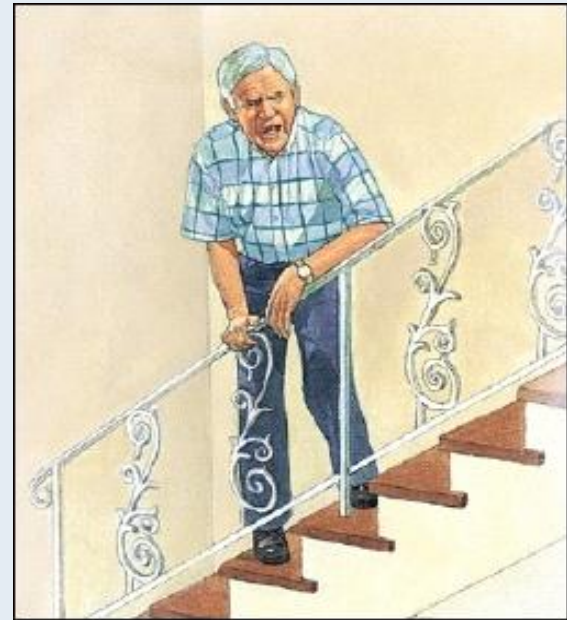
